Description

Objectives:

- Multiplier event to achieve a high dissemination of project results.

- Reflecting on the importance of the role of local communities and youth in the sustainable green energy

Participants:

A total of 51 participants attended the meeting, representing 8 different countries. The majority were from Cyprus, with significant representation from Italy, Romania, Greece, Spain, Hungary, Slovenia and Latvia.

From November 4 to 7, 2025, Athienou hosted the 8th and final international event of the Ed.U.Co project, "Touch Down." The Municipality of Athienou brought together representatives from eight countries to exchange ideas and explore fresh, innovative solutions for sustainability.

DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITIES TAKEN PLACE

04/11/2025

Participants arrived throughout the day and checked in at Sveltos Hotel in Larnaca (Voroklini). In the evening, a group transfer brought all partners to Athienou for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant, offering the opportunity for informal networking and the first cultural introduction to the hosting community.

05/11/2025

- Participants were transferred from the hotel to Athienou Town Hall, where registration took place, followed by a welcome speech by the Mayor of Athienou.
- A video presentation showcased the town's Good Practice in Volunteerism and the achievements of the transfer networks "Volunteering Cities" and "Volunteering Cities+".
- During the Final Conference, partners attended presentations for the Green Points of Larnaca District, the Athienou Wastewater Treatment Plant and recycled water use, and an environmental awareness session by students of Athienou Gymnasium.
- After lunch, the programme continued with a presentation on the Erasmus+ project "CITIZEMP" and an interactive workshop on guidelines and best practices.
- Participants then enjoyed free time in Athienou before gathering for dinner at a local restaurant.

06/11/2025

- The day began with a transfer to Athienou Town Hall and registration.
- Participants attended a guided presentation of the Kallinikeio Municipal Museum, followed by a session on the Final Reporting Structure delivered by CREA360.
- After the coffee break, the Dissemination Event took place across Athienou. Participants engaged informally with the local community, sharing project experiences and outcomes. During this activity, they also had the opportunity to observe traditional halloumi production, visit local churches, and explore the recently renovated Municipal Market, enhancing their understanding of the town's cultural identity.
- After lunch, partners took part in a coordination session led by the Lead Partner and then attended the closing session and wrap-up.
- Free time followed before the group gathered for the farewell dinner.
